He informed about the NBA Accreditation of Diploma programs in Computer Science &amp; Engineering, Electrical Engineering, and Mechanical Engineering. He stated that the IDEA Lab was inaugurated by Prof. (Dr.) T. G. Sitharam, Former Chairman of AICTE, promoting innovation and practical learning. He briefed about the 3-day Faculty Development Workshop focused on NBA Tier-1 preparedness. He also emphasized enhanced alumni engagement and networking through recent initiatives.
